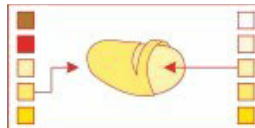


General production advice warepotatoes

Plant populations

Advice planting distance (row distance 75 cm.)

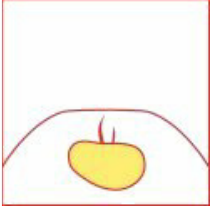
28/35 mm - ca. 51.000 pl./ha. Pl. distance ± 26 cm
 35/50 mm - ca. 47.500 pl./ha. Pl. distance ± 28 cm
 50/55 mm - ca. 45.500 pl./ha. Pl. distance ± 30 cm

Fertilizer

An ample Nitrogen fertilisation is advised.
 Advise about 275 kg N/ha. including soil supply.
 A good Potassium and Phosphorus fertilisation can increase the yield.

Pre-treatment and planting



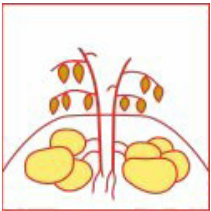
- For normal sprouting, a heat treatment is usually not necessary.
- Sensitive to little potato disorder.
- Do not desprout more than once and don't plant too early in too cold soil.

Growing attentionpoints



- Sensitive to Sencor.
- Emergence is rather quick. Good foliage development and coverage.
- Tubersation is early. Tubers will quickly mature to a bold size.
- Regular and timely spraying against late Blight (*Phytophthora*) is important.

Haulmkillling and harvest



- Little sensitivity to mechanical damage.
- Not sensitive to bruising.

Storage



- The dormancy is moderately long, the storability rather good.
- Can be stored in a mechanical cold store at 4°C.
